About this program: "There is a bylaw that allows a homeowner to create andrent an accessory dwelling unit. It defines anaccessory apartment as an "additional set ofliving facilities with permanent provisions forliving, cooking, and sanitation, located in a single residence dwelling or an accessory building." As part of an on-going effort tomeet a variety of housing needs, the town of Wayland amended the existing bylaw in 1989 by easing two requirements for homeowners willing to contract with the Wayland Housing Authority (WHA) to rent to persons of lowincome. It allows an accessory apartment in ahome on a lot as small as 15,000 square feet and it eliminates the requirement that the principal residence shall have existed for two years."
